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Dear Parents & Guardians of 2nd Year Students,

The procedure for organising students into Higher and Ordinary Level Maths classes is outlined below.

- Two test papers, one higher level and one ordinary level, are set for students at Christmas of 2nd year.
- By opting to take the ordinary level paper students are then committing to taking ordinary level maths for their Junior Cert. Where this is the case the attached permission slip must be returned to their maths teacher.
- This process is repeated in the summer of 2nd year. Two test papers are set and again students who at this stage decide to sit the Ordinary Level must submit written permission from home.
- Students who chose the higher level maths paper in the summer of 2nd year must achieve a minimum mark of 55% in Higher level exam to be automatically assigned to a higher level class in 3rd year.
- Where students do not achieve a mark of 55% and still wish to be considered for higher level maths they must consult with both their maths teacher and career guidance teacher immediately when they return to school in September of 3rd year.
