

What is S.S.E.?

School Self Evaluation is a process of internal school review – it is a collaborative reflective and inclusive process which allows us to continuously improve our school. At F.C.J. Bunclody, the process is led by a Deputy Principal, an AP 1 and an AP 2 Post Holder as well as a Steering Committee.



Who else is involved?

The whole school community. The Principal, The Deputy Principals, and all teachers, under the direction of our Board of Management, in consultation with parents and students. Together we engage in reflective enquiry on the work of our school.



Why do we engage in S.S.E.?

S.S.E. is all about making our school better – by improving and developing. We want to improve the quality of the education we provide for our students. We also want to look at what is working well and build on that.

S.S.E. also means focusing on areas that need developing and deciding on actions that should be taken to bring about improvements in those areas.

The S.S.E process reports to the whole school community about the strengths of the school and identified priorities for improvement and development, as well as celebrating success.

What are the 6 steps of S.S.E?



1. Identify Focus

2. Gather Evidence

3. Analyse and Make Judgements

4. Write and Share Report and Improvement Plan

5. Put Improvement Plan Into Action

6. Monitor Actions and Evaluate Impact

After we have completed the process, we can establish if our targets are working. Do our actions need to be amended? This is all part of the improvement process.
