In light of the fact that an increasing number of our junior students sign up to Studyclix, which costs €49.99 per student for access, the school now purchases a licence which allows all of our 3rd year and senior students to access it for the reduced cost of €20 per student for the academic year, to June 30th. This payment, which will be covered under the JC Free Book Scheme, gives them access to Studyclix Plus. The Studyclix codes will be assigned to students in September.
